Dr. Md. Mobarak Hossain Khan is a Professor and former Chairperson of the Department of Social Relations at East West University (EWU), Dhaka, Bangladesh. Since joining EWU in January 2018, he has been actively involved in teaching, research, and academic leadership. Prior to joining EWU, Dr. Khan held several faculty and research positions at prestigious institutions, including Bielefeld University School of Public Health (Germany), Sapporo Medical University (Japan), King Faisal University (Saudi Arabia), Bangladesh Agricultural University, and Jahangirnagar University (Bangladesh). His academic career spans more than three decades, beginning in 1993. Dr. Khan completed his Habilitation in Urban Health from Bielefeld University, Germany, in 2017. He earned a PhD in Public Health from Sapporo Medical University, Japan, in 2007; an MSc in Community Health and Health Management from Heidelberg University, Germany, in 2000; and both an MSc (1992) and a BSc (1991) in Statistics from Jahangirnagar University, Bangladesh, securing First Class First position in both degrees. He has been awarded several prestigious international scholarships, including the Monbukagakusho (Japanese Government) Scholarship for his doctoral studies in Japan (2002–2007) and the DAAD Scholarship for his master's studies in Germany (1999–2000). Dr. Khan's teaching and research interests include public health—particularly urban health—epidemiology, biostatistics and statistical modeling, research methodology, population studies, and demography. His scholarly achievements are reflected in an outstanding research profile, with over 4,600 citations, an h-index of 38, and an i10-index of 81.
